

Walk

From the town centre take the route south from West Street to the roundabout at the bottom of the hill. Take the road marked to Kilmington and Honiton and follow the pavement on the right over the railway bridge. Just after the bridge, cross the road and descend to the field on the left by the gate and the steps down

the bank. Continue across this field parallel with the wooded embankment on the left; the river Axe is on the right. Go through the gate at the far left and under the bridge.

Continue through the small wood and cross the railway line by the two gates. Follow the footpath by the car park of the carpet factory and turn left onto the road, past the builders' merchant on the left and to the top. At the road junction turn left and continue down to the roundabout from where you can return to the town centre.
